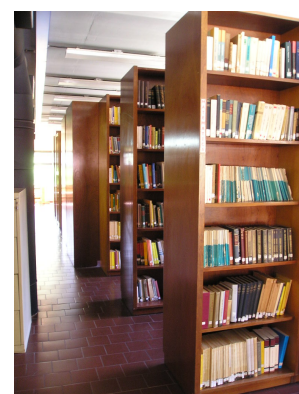
This course will help!
